Criteria:

2. *Must be of Aboriginal ancestry (First Nation, Metis or Non-Status)*
3. *Residency; a person currently living in the Northern Administration District and who has lived here for at least five years prior to date of application are eligible to apply. Students who normally reside in the NAD but are attending school in the south are also eligible.*

Required Documentation:

1. *Completed Application form*
2. *Letter of support from current school by June 30, 2004.*
3. *Letter of support from a community representative/ leader.*
4. *Submit a letter detailing your academic goals, career objectives, interests, and why you feel you should receive this award.*
5. *Must provide an official Grade 12 transcript.*

Preference for one award will be given to a student from the Athabasca Basin.
